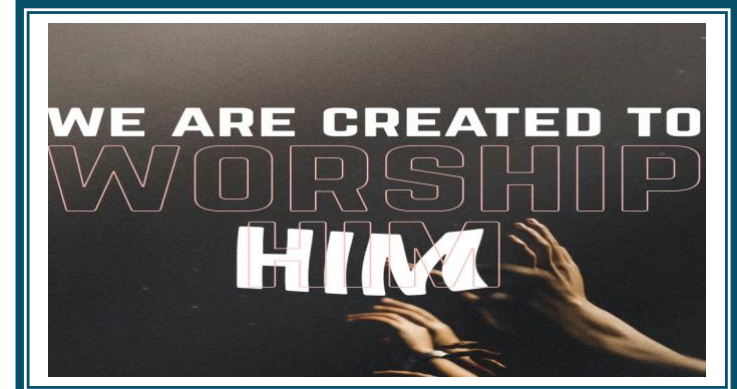

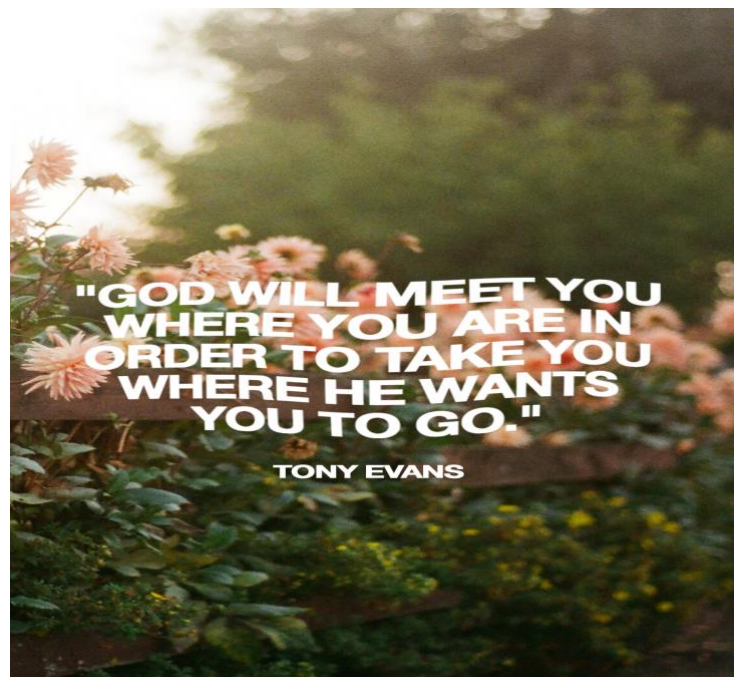


WOMEN'S MINISTRY
